In order to improve cutting-edge knowledge on Rare Hematological Diseases (RHD), <u>ERN-EuroBloodNet</u> is launching a call for <u>ERN-EuroBloodNet Members and Affiliated Partners</u> for attending a preceptorship program held in one highly specialized center for <u>Thalassemia</u>

Highly specialized centers that will host the preceptorships are chosen across Europe and represent the excellence in RHDs field at international level. Indeed, centers have been chosen among ERN-EuroBloodNet HCPs members.

1. PEDAGOGICAL PROJECT

Context

Diagnosis, prognosis and management of haemoglobinopathies (H-disease, β -thalassaemia and sickle-cell disease)

Educational objectives

- 1. Acquire the theoretical and practical basis for the use of diagnostic tools and follow-up of patients with haemoglobinopathies
- 2. Be able to apply the genetic diagnostic and monitoring tools, to take their limitations into account for diagnosis and reporting, and to interpret the results
- 3. Understand and learn how to apply the management protocol of haemoglobinopathies and the program of the clinic, including blood transfusion, chelation treatment, management of complications and follow-up protocols

Contextualised teaching (practical experience)

- 1. Practical experience into the laboratory practice (alongside the biochemists) and explanation of local technological choices in relation to market possibilities.
- 2. Practical experience at the Thalassemia Clinic.

- In a position to follow-up the preceptorship with education projects and activities on medical education.
- Available for the whole duration of the preceptorship.
- English speaker.

4. SELECTION PROCEDURE

In order to participate at this call, candidate must:

- 1. Fulfill the application form available at this link
- 2. Edit a Curriculum vitae
- 3. Write a cover letter
- 4. Send the application form, the curriculum vitae and the cover letter to Dr. Christel Buelens christel.buelens@ulb.be and write as object of the email: "Thalassemia". If you don't get the confirmation of the receipt within few days, please write again.
- It is mandatory to send the candidature by the **20**th of August at midnight (CEST time)
- A jury among ERN-EuroBloodNet members has been established in order to selects participants.
- Gender and geographical balance will be taken into account when making the selection
 of the group, along with the meritocracy of the CV and the motivations expressed in
 the cover letter.

5. COSTS COVERAGES

ERN-EuroBloodNet via Ecorys Agency is in charge to cover the costs for travel (up to €300 for air travel and €200 for rail travel) and accommodation of participants (€200 per working day). It includes daily allowance to cover subsistence, accommodation and travel insurance for professional that travels
